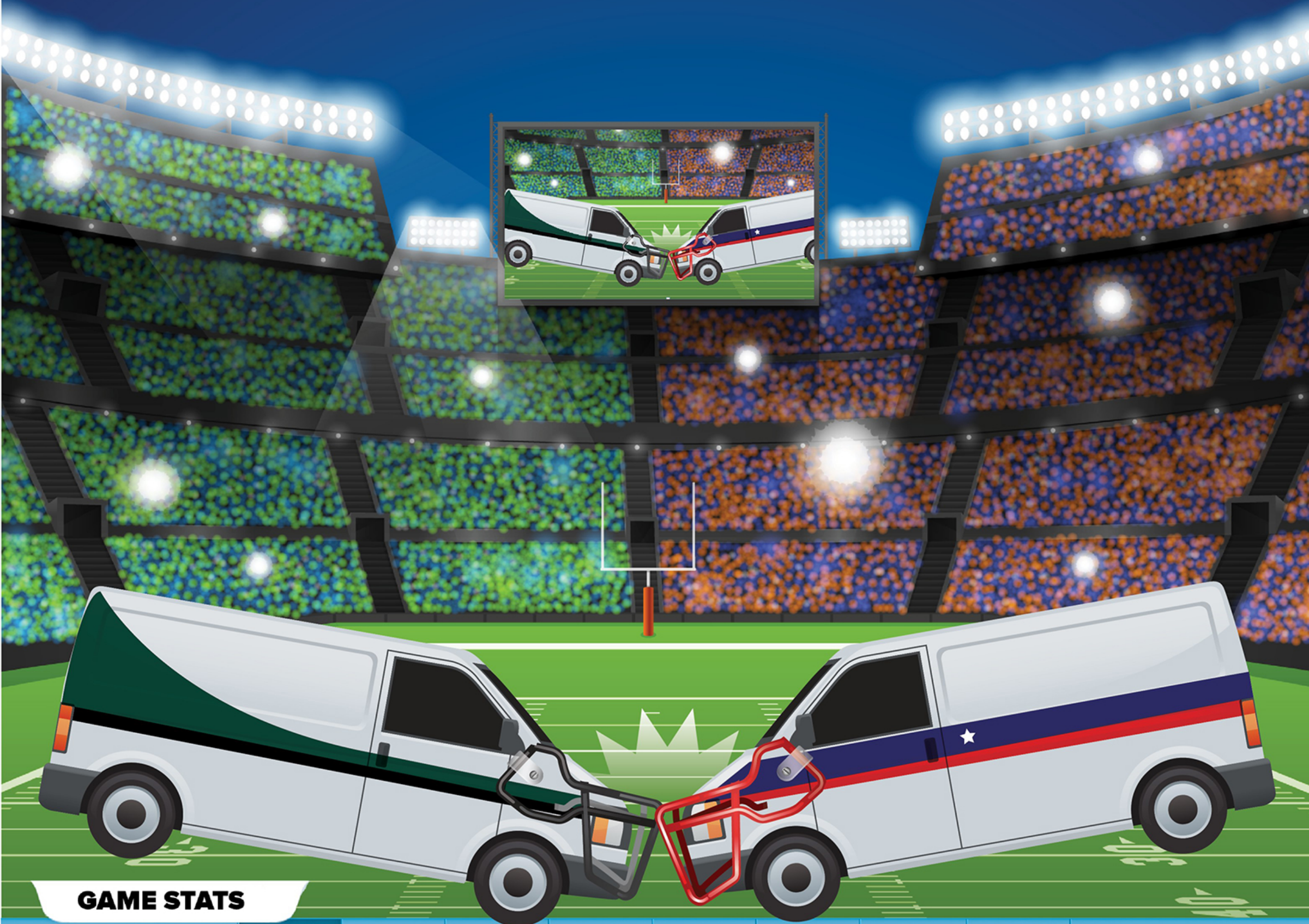

### Philadelphia

<b>Miles driven:</b> New England drives up the field in yards, but on the road Philadelphia drives more miles.		 <b>Philadelphia drives 8% more miles than Boston.</b>
<b>Speeding:</b> While speeding is not recommended on the road, it is important to be fast on the football field. Looks like Philadelphia takes the lead on the field but needs to slow down on the road.	 <b>New England speeds 29% less than Philadelphia.</b>	
<b>Hard braking:</b> A QB sack is equivalent to hard braking on the road. Philadelphia needs to work harder on and off the field in this category.	  <b>New England hard brakes 25% less than Philadelphia.</b>	
<b>Unsafe driving:</b> Make sure to stay alert, Philadelphia. Unsafe driving can lead to dangerous consequences, just like lack of focus can cause an interception.	  <b>New England has almost 25% less unsafe driving incidents than Philadelphia.</b>
